Ezekiel 38:6 = the **Cimmerians**, an Indo-European people who settled Cappadocia from the north coast of the Black Sea between the Don and the Danube. See Homer <u>The Odyssey</u> 11.14.

Also Ezekiel 38:2; 39:6; Apocalypse 20:8 = probably the **land of Gog** [Gugu, Gyges] = **Lydia** in western Anatolia, with its capital at Sardis, of which Gog was the first king. He was also the ancestor of the famous Croesus.

= the **Medes**. See Isaiah 13:17; 21:2; Jeremiah 25:25; 51:11,28; 2 Kings 17:6; 18:11. An Indo-European people, from northeastern Assyria closely associated in history with the Persians.

= the **Ionians** of western Anatolia (Ezekiel 27:13; Isaiah 66:19). After Alexander the Great 'Javan' referred to the **Greeks** generally (Joel 4:8; Zechariah 9:13; Daniel 8:21; 10:20; 11:2).

mentioned together in Ezekiel 27:13; 32:26; 38:2f; 39:1; Isaiah 66:19 in Septuagint = Peoples inhabiting **Cilicia and Phrygia.**

= one of the Indo-European Sea Peoples who, along with the Philistines, attacked Egypt in the 13th Century BC. Probably the **Tyrrhenians** from the islands of the Aegean [related to the Etruscans? Thracians?].

Jeremiah 51:27 = **Scythians** who replaced the Cimmerians as rulers of the north Black Sea.

Josephus claims these are the **Paphlygonians** from between the Black Sea and Bythinia.

Ezekiel 27:13f; 38:3-6 = same area, probably a city bordering Tubal (above).

Verses 26-30 refer to tribes, mostly from South Arabia, east of Yemen.

Joktan begot Almodad, Sheleph, Hazarmaveth, Jerah Hadoram, Uzal, Diklah Obal, Abimael, Sheba Ophir, Havilah, Jobab. All these are the sons of Joktan.

- Hazarmaveth is modern Hadramaut on the southwest coast of Arabia.
- Sheba, Genesis 25:3
- Ophir Famous for its gold. Often mentioned in the Bible (Psalm 45:10). Probably in Arabia.

And their territory extends from Mesha towards Separ as far as the mountains in the east. These are the descendants of Shem, by their families, their languages, their lands, and their tnations.
